Itinerary:-

Friday 2nd September 2011

10.05am Group will be met at Rome's Ciampino Airport by our guide Stephen Burstin, a resident of Rome. Coach to Rome city centre with a commentary on interesting sites being presented en route. Stop-off at Fosse Ardeatine, for guided tour of the memorial site and scene of the 1944 Nazi massacre, including 75 Roman Jews. Proceed to hotel via Ghetto to stock up first on kosher groceries.

2.00pm Ancient Rome guided tour, finishing at about 5.00pm whereupon we will be starting on Circo Massimo the ancient Arena the site of the chariot races within the famous Palantine Hill, where we will see the site of the ancient Jewish burial site at Aventine cemetery during the time of the ghetto. We visit the Coliseum with all the accompanying myths and stories and horrors and Jewish connections. We then walk the Roman forum the original shopping centre at Trajan markets stopping at the arch of Titus commemorating the sacking of Jerusalem in 70 CE still in wonderfully condition.

7.15 - Leaving hotel for Minchah and Kabalat services at the Great Synagogue followed by Shabbat meal in the ghetto

Saturday 3rd September

9 am Shabbat services at the Great Synagogue followed by Shabbat lunch at the kosher restaurant Approx 2pm – Classic Rome escorted leisurely walk enjoying a combination of the City's most picturesque fountains, squares and alleyways with some of her finest architectural and artistic monuments. Sites such as Piazza Navona, Campo de Fiori, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Venezia and the Pantheon with its magnificient dome.

Sunday 4th September

10.00am Jewish Ghetto guided tour [3 hours] of the ghetto and surrounding area to discover the incredible 2,200 years history. We see a thriving and bustling community today and visit the great Synagogue to admire its grandeur and the museum [voted one of the best in all Italy] to view amazing relics of Rome's rich Jewish heritage
